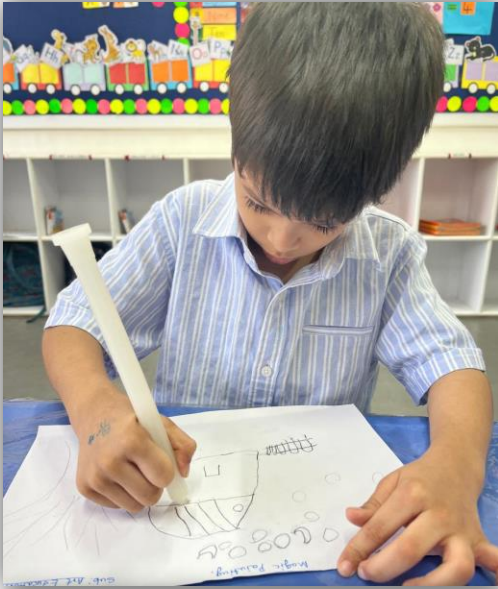
Hidden Art, Magic Start
