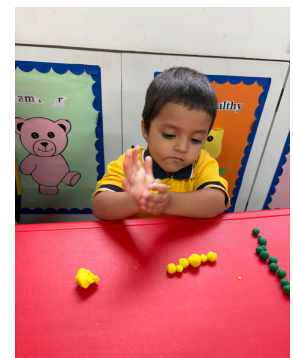

Our Grade 1 students enjoyed a fun learning activity on "Elephant and Its Body Parts."

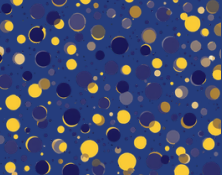
